## Our services



### Learning Through Play Sessions

Activities for children with additional needs from 9.15-14.45 on weekdays (except Friday afternoons). Rated Ofsted outstanding.

### Family Support

Listening to families in our Centres or at home. Supporting at meetings with other professionals. Giving information and signposting to other services.

### Family Education

Training courses, stay and play sessions and joint sessions with other professionals to help families learn more about how to support their child's development.

### Supporting Providers

Providers Advisory Support Service (PASS) helps mainstream providers to include children with additional needs.
